**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2026**

Southern Water Services works.

To allow sewer pipe works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lossenham Lane, Newenden.

A closure is planned from 3rd August 2026, with estimated completion by 13th August 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT14565240-02 - Southern Water Services). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Lossenham Lane will be closed at the junction with A28 Rye Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while sewer pipe works are undertaken by Southern Water Services.

There is no alternative route for this closure, however, residential and emergency access will be maintained at all times when it is safe to do so.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
